SUBJECT: SAFETY ALERT - SPEED WARNING

Be advised, the maximum safe operating speed of the Allied Systems "Wagner Lumberjack" Logstacker is defined as the maximum speed attainable by the unit unloaded and on level ground. It is possible for the Lumberjack to exceed this maximum safe speed when travelling on a downhill grade. Exceeding the designed maximum safe speed may place the machine and operator in a dangerous condition, as the machine's stopping distance will be beyond the maximum design criteria. Exceeding the maximum safe speed may also lead to unforeseen component failure, including, but not limited to drivelines. Proper operation can eliminate this danger.

It is recommended that the operator place the transmission into 1st, 2nd, or 3rd gear, and/or apply appropriate braking, prior to descending a downward slope. This will prevent the machine from exceeding its maximum safe speed.
