Fuse Panels

There are two fuse panels; one mounted on the chassis, right side (see Figure 2-9-1), and one mounted inside the cab, lower right (see Figure 2-9-3).

Note: The ECM Communications Port is located near the panel inside the cab.

Remove the plastic box cover to access the fuses and relays.



Before you remove the plastic box cover, be sure that the machine's ignition is turned off.

The fuse amperage is printed on the fuse. A fuse may be inspected by pulling it out and inspecting the filament. If it has burned through, the fuse needs to be replaced. See Figure 2-9-2.

Replace a blown fuse with an equivalent fuse of the same amperage.



Never replace a fuse with one that has different amperage than the original. The new fuse must be the same color and size as the one you're replacing.
