

## **Foot Pedals**

## 1. Deceleration Pedal

The Deceleration Pedal reduces engine speed, and is typically used to override the speed set by the throttle lock, to slow the machine temporarily. The engine speed will return to the throttle lock setting when the pedal is released.

## 2. Brake Pedal

Foot controlled pedal will engage the service brakes. Will also "declutch" the transmission if the declutch function is activated.

## 3. Throttle Pedal

Foot controlled engine throttle pedal.




Figure 2-7-1 Foot Pedals
